Thursday, April 27 (Low tide 9:54 a.m. – 4.9 feet)

Friday, April 28 (Low tide 10:38 am – 5.1 feet)

Dear Families of HMS 7th Graders,

During the next set of super-low tides, all 7th grade students will spend a day at Ocean Shores Beach collecting data on the life found in the intertidal ecosystem. This is part of a global censusing project and part of the 7th grade science curriculum. Students will be observing, measuring, classifying, recording and communicating scientific data about the macroalgae and invertebrates of Kachemak Bay.

Students will be grouped in one of four groups. Two groups will spend Thursday, April 27 at the beach. The other two groups will spend Friday, April 28 at the beach. On the day that students are not scheduled for the science trip to the beach, they will participate in two other fantastic learning opportunities. On the non-beach day, each student will spend most of the morning practicing cold-water survival skills at the Kate Kuhns Aquatic Center, and the afternoon helping mentor Paul Banks Elementary students and teaching marine ecology here at Homer Middle School. The schedule for the two days is detailed on an attached page.

Students need to be at school at 8:30 (regular start time) both days. For the science field trip, students need clothing appropriate for being on the often cold, windy beach all day. All students **MUST WEAR WATERPROOF BOOTS!** Students need to bring a lunch and raingear in a daypack to carry to the beach.

On the pool day, each student needs to bring a swimsuit and a towel since everyone will be getting wet when they try out life jackets, survival suits and the life raft. Students will be transported by bus to the pool and back to Homer Middle School for lunch at 12:30.

On both days, students will be back at school to meet buses by 3:15. All trips will happen rain or shine. We would love to have a few parents accompany the field trips as chaperones and assistants. Please let us know if you would like to come along and help.
